Criteria for the AAPE Youth Exhibit Awards

Youth = less than age 19 as of January 1.

There are 3 ribbons for First, Second and Third place for the three best Youth philatelic exhibits, regardless of medal level. If there are fewer than three Youth exhibits, the ribbons should be awarded accordingly. AAPE recommends that juries consider BEST without strict adherence to the points achieved.

AAPE Youth Grand Award makes the exhibit eligible for the AAPE Youth Champion of Champions.

The AAPE Youth Champion of Champions Exhibition Year = April 1 to March 31

The AAPE Youth Grand Award is separate from any Youth awards given by the host show.
