The entries will be judged for an overall champion, plus a youth group, adult, APS Chapters and Clubs, and a professional category to include stamp dealers. The prize for the overall Champion will be \$250.00 and the other categories will receive \$50.00 (cash or in-kind gift certificates) per category. Donations have been received from A&D Stamps, Ed Dimmock and Labron Harris, Wade Saadi, Omar Rodrigues, Janet Klug, Cheryl Edgcomb and Ian Gibson-Smith. Announcement of winners will be in July 2011.
