INSTRUCTIONS TO EXHIBITOR: For as complete a critique as possible submit all the pages (Max. No of Pages: 160) of ONE of the philatelic exhibits with this application. Your exhibit will be critiqued in writing by a qualified exhibitor/judge, as best as possible, on the basis of your specialty. Exhibit submitted must be the sole property of the exhibitor.

STIPULATIONS: 1) Submit 4 copies of this application together with a CLEAR FULL SIZED PHOTOCOPY of the exhibit you wish critiqued (single sided). 2) NUMBER PAGES on the front lower right or left and send in order. 3) Include inside TWO (#) sturdy KRAFT type envelopes. DO NOT use the plastic types nor Jiffy bags, they tear and are not biodegradable. 4) DO NOT use cardboard around the pages nor put them in a binder of any kind as they tear the envelopes as well as add weight. 5) Include loose postage of TWICE the amount needed to mail your exhibit as it must be mailed twice en route back to you. Note: for envelopes over 12 ounces the rate is \$3.85 as Priority Mail and should be so marked. 6) Enclose a stamped (commem please) UNADDRESSED #10 envelope. 7) The judges will write on the pages as appropriate and will put a summary on the rear of the application. 8) The judge remains anonymous at his or her discretion. 9) The photocopied pages need not be insured but if you do please include sufficient postage for return in the same manner. 10) Try to give as much lead time before a coming show as possible so that the critique isn't hurried. In addition many of the judges have other commitments which at time preclude getting a critique done in a short time. Allow yourself time for the critique to be done as well as time to redo what pages may have to be redone or the entire exhibit if necessary.
